

## **Ordinance No. 88**

### **Entitled:**

An Ordinance taking a certain platted adjoining tract of land into the City of Burlingame. Whereas a certain tract of land lying adjoining to the City limits of the City of Burlingame has been subdivided into lots, block, streets and alleys, and a plat of the same has been filed in the office of the Register of Deeds of Osage County Kansas, which said tract of land is known and designated as an addition to the City of Burlingame by the name set forth in Section II of this ordinance, therefore be it ordained by the Mayor and Councilmen of the City of Burlingame.

### **Section I.**

That all the following described tract of land situated in the County of Osage and State of Kansas be and the same is hereby taken into the City of Burlingame and made to all intents and for all purposes contemplated in the law under which said City is organized, a part of said city which said tract of land is described as follows to wit:

Commencing at the N.E. corner of the S.E. quarter of Section fifteen (15) in township no. fifteen (15) South of Range No. fourteen (14) East, thence west seventy-eight (78) rods and seven links, thence South ninety-six (96) rods to the north line of the right-of-way of the M.A. & B. railroad company, thence in a north easterly direction along the right of way of said R. R. Company to the East line of said quarter Section of land, thence north to place of beginning, containing thirty-two (32) A. more or less.

### **Section II.**

That all the territory and tract of land described in the preceding Section and known as South Park addition to the City of Burlingame be and the same is hereby added to the City of Burlingame and made to all intents and purposes contemplated in the law under which said City is organized, a part of said City.

### **Section III.**

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication once in the Burlingame Democrat.
