

Ordinance No. 172

Entitled:

An ordinance to extend the limits of the City of Burlingame, Kansas. Be it ordained by the Mayor and Councilmen of the City of Burlingame, Kansas.

Section I.

The City limits of the City of Burlingame be and hereby are extended to take into said city and include within the limits thereof the following described property: Commencing at the Southwest corner of the Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section eleven (11), township fifteen (15), range fourteen (14) east of the Sixth Principal Meridian, thence north nine hundred (900) feet, thence east five hundred five (505) feet to the public road, thence Southwesterly along the west side of said road to a point where said road crosses the South line of the said Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section eleven (11) thence west one hundred forty eight and one half feet (148 ½) to the place of beginning.

Section II.

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication once in the Burlingame Enterprise.
