

ORDINANCE NO. 1860

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TRAFFIC AND ESTABLISHING STOP SIGNS AT DESIGNATED INTERSECTIONS WITHIN THE CITY OF BURLINGAME, KANSAS.

WHEREAS, the City of Burlingame, Kansas has determined by a traffic study that stop signs are needed at certain intersections and the placement of the same would be in the interest of public safety and welfare.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF Burlingame, KANSAS:

Section 1. There shall be placed a traffic control sign for purpose of regulating traffic at the following designated intersections in the City of Burlingame, Kansas:

- a) At the intersection of Osage Street and Dayton Avenue Street, stop signs shall be erected on Osage Street for southbound and northbound traffic.
- b) At the intersection of Hall Avenue and Seneca Street, stop signs shall be erected on Hall Street for eastbound and westbound traffic.
- c) At the intersection of Lincoln Avenue and Delaware Street, stop signs shall be erected on Lincoln Avenue for eastbound and westbound traffic.
- d) At the intersection of Seneca Street and Dayton Avenue, stop signs shall be erected on Seneca Street for southbound and northbound traffic.
- e) A stop sign shall be erected on Fast Drive where Fast Drive meets Highway 31 for south-bound traffic.

Section 2. It shall be unlawful for any person to violate any traffic control sign erected in accordance with this ordinance, and any person found guilty or convicted or upon entry of a plea of guilty or nolo contendere for a violation of this ordinance, shall be subject to a fine in an amount not less than \$20.00 nor more than \$100.00 for each violation.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage by the governing body, approval by the Mayor, and publication in the official city newspaper.
