

ORDINANCE NO. 1913

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 1714 AND PROVIDING FOR A CHANGE OF ZONING OF A TRACT OF LAND FROM SINGLE FAMILY RESIDENTIAL TO COMMERCIAL USE.

WHEREAS, the Burlingame Planning and Zoning Commission at a duly called meeting approved and recommended to the governing body a request for a change of zoning from R-single family residential use, to C-Commercial use, of a tract of land in Burlingame, Kansas.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF BURLINGAME, KANSAS:

Ordinance 1714 is hereby amended as follows:

SECTION 1: The following tract of land located within the City limits of the City of Burlingame, Kansas, to-wit: East ½ of Lot 14, Lot 15, the West 15 feet of Lot 16 in Block 14 of the Original Town of the City of Burlingame, Kansas, be rezoned to C-Commercial and that a proper change to the zoning classification shall be made on the map disclosing the zoning in the City of Burlingame, Kansas.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be effective upon it's passage by the governing body, approval by the Mayor, and publication in the official City newspaper.
