

ORDINANCE NO. 1955

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ZONING ORDINANCE 1714 AND PROVIDING FOR A CHANGE OF ZONING OF A TRACT OF LAND TO A MULTIPLE FAMILY RESIDENTIAL USE.

WHEREAS, the Burlingame Planning and Zoning Commission at a duly called meeting approved and recommended to the governing body a request for a change of zoning to multiple family dwelling use of a tract of land in Burlingame/ Kansas.

NOW/ THEREFORE/ BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF BURLINGAME, KANSAS:

Ordinance 1714 is hereby amended as follows:

Section 1; The following tract of land located within the City limits of the City of Burlingame, Kansas, to-wit: Lots 12, 13, and 14 in Block 27 of the Original Town of the City of Burlingame, Kansas, be rezoned to R-2 Multiple Dwelling for the purpose of allowing the potential use of the two buildings located on said property as multiple dwelling units.

Section 2; Ordinance 1714 of the City of Burlingame, Kansas, is hereby amended to read that: Lots 12, 13, and 14 in Block 27 of the Original Town of the City of Burlingame, Kansas, is hereby rezoned to R-2 Multiple Dwelling, and that a proper change to the zoning classification shall be made on the map disclosing the zoning in the City of Burlingame, Kansas.

Section 3: This Ordinance shall be effective upon its passage by the governing body, approval by the Mayor, and publication in the official City newspaper.
