

ORDINANCE NO. 2203

AN ORDINANCE FOR ENERGY COST ADJUSTMENT TO RATES FOR ELECTRICITY OF THE CITY OF BURLINGAME, KANSAS, AND REPEALING ORDINANCE 2158.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF BURLINGAME, KANSAS, to wit:

SECTION 1. The rates for energy for all rate schedules shall be increased or decreased by \$0.00001 per kWh (KWH) for each \$0.00001 increase or decrease in the aggregate cost of energy per kWh as computed by the following formula:

$$\left( \frac{\text{The purchased power and fuel cost for the previous 12 months}}{\text{The total loss adjusted kWhs purchased or generated over same 12 months}} - \left( \frac{\text{The total cost of power}}{\text{during base period}} \right) \right) * \text{avg. system loss factor} = \text{ECA}$$

This Energy Cost adjustment will be applicable to all retail rate schedules offered by the City. The cost of power during base period is \$ 0.045 per kWh., and the average system loss factor is 112%.

SECTION 2.. The previous 12 months will be adjusted to reflect the loss adjustment in purchase power already experienced by City.

SECTION 3. That Ordinance 2158 is hereby repealed
