

ORDINANCE NO. 2204

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 15-307 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF BURLINGAME AND ESTABLISHING NEW ELECTRIC USER RATES FOR SERVICE RECEIVED FROM SAID SYSTEM AND REPEALING CITY ORDINANCE NO. 2159.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF BURLINGAME, KANSAS, to wit:

SECTION 1 That the municipal electric light and power system, beginning with the December, 2013 usage billed in the month of January, 2014 shall furnish electrical power consumed or used within and outside the corporate limits at the following monthly charges and rates:

Residential Monthly Service Customer Charge	\$7.00
Residential Monthly Service Customer Charge – Outside City	\$9.00
Commercial Monthly Service Customer Charge	\$13.00
Commercial Monthly Service Customer Charge – Outside City	\$15.00
Residential Energy Charge	10.16 cents/kWh
Commercial Energy Charge	9.95 cents/kWh
Residential Energy Charge – Outside City	13.00 cents/kWh
Commercial Energy Charge– Outside City	15.00 cents/kWh

SECTION 2. A demand charge of 17 cents per kWh transformer capacity shall be charged on all 3-phase meter outlets outside the City limits

SECTION 3. The charges are in addition to the Energy Cost Adjustment of Ordinance 2203.

SECTION 4. Customers using the above electric rate schedule shall be subject to the same rules, regulations and ordinances that govern all other utility customers.

SECTION 5. That Ordinance 2159 is hereby repealed

SECTION 6. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication in the official City newspaper.
