

ORDINANCE NO. 2214

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE WATER UTILITY SYSTEM OF THE CITY OF BURLINGAME AND SETTING THE RATES AND CHARGES FOR SERVICE RECEIVED FROM SAID SYSTEM AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 2169.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF BURLINGAME KANSAS, to wit:

SECTION 1. That rates for water delivered, metered and sold by the municipal water department, excluding water sold through special benefit districts, shall be as follows:

Minimum monthly charge of \$19.00 for 1,000 gallons and under. Over 1,000 gallons at 84.2 cents per 100 gallon or \$8.42 for 1,000 gallons.

SECTION 2. That rates for water delivered, metered and sold by the municipal water department to special benefit districts shall be as follows:

Minimum monthly charge of \$23.00 for 1,000 gallons and under. Over 1,000 gallons at 89.2 cents per 100 gallon or \$8.92 for 1,000 gallons.

SECTION 3. That the term, special benefit district, shall mean all water customers outside of the City limits.

SECTION 4. That water haulers will be charged \$8.52 per 1,000 gallon or 85.2 cents per 100 gallon.

SECTION 5. That the above rates and charges are effective with the October 2014 usage billed in the month of November.

SECTION 6. That Ordinance No. 2169 is hereby repealed.

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage by the Governing body, approved by the mayor, and published in the official City newspaper.
