

ORDINANCE NO.2369

AN ORDINANCE FOR ENERGY COST ADJUSTMENT TO RATES FOR ELECTRICITY OF THE CITY OF BURLINGAME, KANSAS, AND REPEALING ORDINANCE 2203

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF BURLINGAME, KANSAS, to-wit:

SECTION 1. The rates for energy for all rate schedules shall be increased or decreased by \$0.00001 per kWh (KWH) for each \$0.00001 increase or decrease in the aggregate cost of energy per kWh as computed by the following formula:

$$\left( \left( \begin{array}{l} \text{The purchased power and fuel cost for the previous twelve months} \\ \text{The total kWhs purchased or produced over the previous twelve months} \end{array} \right) - \left( \begin{array}{l} \text{The total cost of} \\ \text{power during base period} \end{array} \right) \right)$$

\*average system = ECA  
loss factor

This Energy Cost adjustment will be applicable to all retail rate schedules offered by the City. The cost of power during base period is \$0.0225 per kWh, and the average system loss factor is 112%.

SECTION 2. The previous 12 months will be adjusted to reflect the loss adjustment in purchase power already experienced by City.

SECTION 3. Ordinance 2203 is hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication in the official City newspaper.
