

ORDINANCE NO.2371

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 15-307 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF BURLINGAME AND ESTABLISHING NEW ELECTRIC USER RATES FOR SERVICE RECEIVED FROM SAID SYSTEM AND REPEALING CITY ORDINANCE NO. 2204.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF BURLINGAME, KANSAS, to-wit:

Section 1. That the municipal electric light and power system, beginning with the December 2017 usage billed in the month of January, shall furnish electrical power consumed or used within and outside the corporate limits at the following monthly charges and rates:

Residential Minimum Monthly Service Charge	\$ 7.50
Residential Minimum Monthly Service Charge-Outside City	\$ 9.50
Commercial Minimum Monthly Service Charge	\$13.50
Commercial Minimum Monthly Service Charge-Outside City	\$15.50
Residential	8.36 cents/kWh
Commercial	8.15 cents/kWh
Residential-Outside City	11.20 cents/kWh
Commercial-Outside City	13.20 cents/kWh

Section 2. A demand charge of 17 cents per kWh transformer capacity shall be charged on all 3-phase meter outlets outside the City limits.

Section 3. The charges are in addition to the Energy Cost Adjustment of Ordinance 2369.

Section 4. Customers using the above electric rate schedule shall be subject to the same rules, regulations and ordinances that govern all other utility customers.

Section 5. That Ordinance 2204 is hereby repealed.

Section 6. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication in the official City newspaper.
