

ORDINANCE NO. 2372

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 7 OF ORDINANCE _____ REGARDING REGISTRATION AND PAYMENT OF REGISTRATION FEE FOR OPERATING SPECIAL PURPOSE VEHICLE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF BURLINGAME, KANSAS, to-wit:

Section 1. Section 7 of Ordinance 2181 regarding the payment of registration fees is hereby amended in the following manner:

Section 7. SAME; REGISTRATION; FEE, APPLICATION, INSPECTION. Before operating any special purpose utility vehicle on any public highway, street, road or alley within the corporate limits of the city, the vehicle shall be registered with the police department and payment of a registration fee and display a valid registration decal affixed and displayed in such a manner as to be clearly visible from the rear of the vehicle. The application shall be made upon forms provided by the city and each application shall contain the name of the owner, the owner's residence address, or bona fide place of business, a brief description of the vehicle to be registered (including make, model and serial number, if applicable). Proof of insurance, as required in Section 6 shall be furnished at the time of application for registration. The registration fee shall be \$2.00 per month calculated on the number of months from date of application until the end of the calendar year plus a \$1.00 processing fee. The registration fee for the first month shall be due when the application is submitted regardless of the day of the month when the application is submitted. The registration issued hereunder is not transferrable. For purposes of this ordinance the annual registration shall be for the period of time from January 1 or for first time registration from date of application until December 31 of each year. Each registration regardless of the date issued shall expire on December 31 and a new application and payment of registration fee shall be required each year. Regardless of the date of registration that all registrations shall be dated to expire on December 31.

Section 2. Ordinance 2181 is hereby repealed.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after passage by the governing body, approval by the Mayor and publication in the official city newspaper.
