

RESOLUTION 355

WHEREAS, the City of Burlingame, Kansas, has been mandated by the United States Department of Transportation to establish and regularly update a public awareness plan to educate customers and non-customers who live or work near our pipelines to recognize the odor of natural gas and how to respond to possible detections; and

WHEREAS, early recognition of natural gas odor saves lives and prevents property damage; and

WHEREAS, it is the goal of the governing body to raise awareness of the affected public and key stakeholders of the presence of buried natural gas pipelines; and

WHEREAS, a more informed public will play a greater role in preventing the loss of life and property through a coordinated and integrated public awareness campaign; and

WHEREAS, the City of Burlingame has demonstrated management support for and has allocated resources to implement a Public Awareness Program;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, THE City Council for the City of Burlingame, Kansas hereby adopts a public awareness program, the terms of which are contained in a Public Awareness Program for the City of Burlingame, Kansas and dated April 2, 2012.
