

Security Plan

Burlingame Municipal Buildings

(City Hall-Police Dept.-Utility Dept.-Council Chambers-Municipal Court)

Purpose: The purpose of this security plan is to comply with the Kansas Four Year Exemption statute. This Security Plan has been developed for the building being exempted which supplies adequate security to the occupants of the building and merits the prohibition of the carrying of a concealed handgun as authorized by the personal and family protection act.


Building Description: The building being exempt is located at 101 E. Santa Fe in Burlingame, KS. This building is commonly referred to as Burlingame City Hall and also houses the Burlingame Police Department, Burlingame Municipal Court, Burlingame Council Chambers, and the Burlingame Utility Department.

Security Threats: The goal of the Governing Body of the City of Burlingame is to ensure the safety of its citizens, and guests. It is the Governing Bodies concern that allowing any firearm, whether concealed or open, inside any municipal building poses a threat to its employees, citizens and guests.

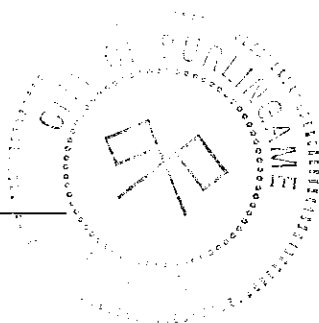
Security Measures: The Burlingame Police Department is located in the same building as City Hall, Council Chambers, Municipal Court and the Burlingame Utility Dept. The Burlingame Police Department consists of uniformed and armed officers. The Burlingame Police Department will provide it's officers with handheld metal detectors to search persons entering City Hall for concealed weapons if the need arises for the protection of the persons within. Uniformed and armed officers of the Burlingame Police Department will be present at all Council Meetings and at Burlingame Municipal Court. Burlingame City Hall will be monitored by 24 hour closed circuit television. All entrances will be posted with the legal, no firearms allowed signs as approved by the Kansas Attorney General.

Notice: A notice of the City of Burlingame's intent to apply for a four year exemption shall be sent to the Kansas Attorney General's Office and a copy of this resolution shall be kept at Burlingame City Hall.

Review: All employees of the City of Burlingame will meet annually to review security concerns and procedures within City Hall.
