
BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF BURLINGAME, KANSAS:

**7-305. PERMIT FOR SALE OF FIREWORKS REQUIRED; FEE; ISSUANCE**





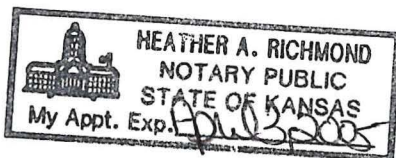
