

ORDINANCE NO. 2140

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING A CITYWIDE RETAILERS' SALES TAX IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE PERCENT (1.0%) WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF BURLINGAME KANSAS, FOR THE PURPOSE OF IMPROVEMENTS TO THE INFRASTRUCTURE, EFFECTIVE APRIL 1ST, 2009.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL MEMBERS OF THE CITY OF BURLINGAME, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. A majority of the electors voting thereon having approved, at a special question election held on the 4th day of November, 2008, the levying of a citywide retailers' sales tax in the City of Burlingame, for the purposes of improvements to the infrastructure, as authorized by K.S.A. 12-187 *et seq.*, and amendments thereto, there is hereby levied a citywide retailers' sales tax in the amount of one percent (1.0%) to take effect on the 1st day of April, 2009.

SECTION 2. Except as otherwise be provided by law, such tax shall be identical in its application and exemptions therefrom to the Kansas Retailers' Sales Tax Act and all laws and administrative rules and regulations of the Kansas Department of Revenue relating to the state retailers' tax shall apply to such city retailers' sales tax insofar as such laws and regulations may be made applicable. The services of the Department of Revenue shall be utilized to administer, enforce and collect such tax.

SECTION 3. Resolution 312 is hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall be published one time in the official county newspaper, and a copy duly certified and submitted to the state director of taxation.


