

ORDINANCE NO. 1699

AN ORDINANCE NUMBERING LOTS AND PARTS OF LOTS IN THE CITY OF BURLINGAME, KANSAS; RENAMING SOME STREETS; REQUIRING ASSIGNED NUMBERS TO BE PLACED ON ALL BUILDINGS, HOUSES AND OTHER STRUCTURES LOCATED THEREIN; AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF BURLINGAME, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. All lots and parts of lots abutting any street or avenue in the City of Burlingame, Kansas, shall be numbered and all business buildings, dwelling houses and other structures located therein shall have numbers affixed thereto by the owners or the agents of the owners thereof, as hereinafter designated.

SECTION 2. Each 25 foot space shall constitute a whole number. Topeka Avenue shall constitute the base line for all streets and avenues in said City which run east and west. Each 25 foot space on the south side shall be numbered with odd numbers and each such space on the north side shall be even numbers. Each 25 foot space in the first block either east or west of Topeka Avenue shall be numbered 100 and upward; 200 and upward in the second block, and so on to a point approximately one mile in each direction from the Topeka Avenue and Santa Fe Avenue intersection. Numbers on streets and avenues running east from Topeka Avenue shall be known as "East" numbers and numbers on streets and avenues running west from Topeka Avenue shall be known as "West" numbers.

Santa Fe Avenue shall constitute the base line for all streets and avenues in said City which run north and south. Each 25 foot space on the east side of said streets and avenues shall be numbered with even numbers and each such space on the west side shall be odd numbers. Each 25 foot space in the first block either north or south of Santa Fe Avenue shall be numbered 100 and upward; 200 and upward in the second block, and so on to a point approximately one mile in each direction from the Topeka Avenue and Santa Fe Avenue intersection. Numbers on streets and avenues running north of Santa Fe Avenue shall be known as "North" numbers and numbers on streets and avenues running south of Santa Fe Avenue shall be known as "South" numbers.

SECTION 3. Streets and avenues which do not intersect or extend to the base line shall be numbered as if they did so extend to and intersect said base line and shall be numbered with the same hundred numbers of corresponding blocks adjacent to the street that do intersect or extend to the base street or avenue.

SECTION 4. The following streets will be renamed in the Addition known as South Park: First to Ash Street; Second to Oak Street; Third to Walnut Street.

SECTION 5. In case there are two or more dwellings, buildings or rooms, including streets, stairway entrances, located on the same 25 foot space, the second dwelling, building or entrance shall be numbered the same with alphabetical letters following in the sequence as needed.

SECTION 6. All numbering of business buildings, dwelling houses and other structures located in the City of Burlingame shall be determined by the street to which it faces or fronts as set out in Section 2.

SECTION 7. In case of doubt or dispute, or if a question arises as to the proper number assigned to any lot or building or structure, the City Clerk of the City of Burlingame, Kansas, shall decide and fix the number of such lot, building or structure, and such decision shall be final.

SECTION 8. The numbering placed on any building or structure shall be at least 6 inches in height, made of non-rusting material and shall be of such color and placed on the building or other structure in such a position that it can be easily seen from the street fronting the building, structure or entrance intended to be numbered.

SECTION 9. All persons, firms, corporations, associations and organizations owning, occupying or having control of any building or other structures fronting or facing any of the public streets and avenues of the City of Burlingame are hereby required to number such buildings or other structures, as provided herein, within 120 days after notification of the new address, and all new structures constructed after elapse of such time, must be so numbered within 30 days after completion or occupancy, whichever is earlier.

SECTION 10. Any person, firm, corporation, association or organization convicted of violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be fined a sum not exceeding \$25.00, and each day such violation is found to occur shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 11. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the official City newspaper.
