

ORDINANCE NO. 2183

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER VII SECTION 303(a) and SECTION 304 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF BURLINGAME KANSAS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF BURLINGAME, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. Section 7-303 of Article 3, Fire, of Chapter VII, Fireworks, of the Code of the City of Burlingame, Kansas, is hereby amended to read as follows:

SAME: EXCEPTIONS; DISCHARGES. (a) Section of this article shall not apply to the firing or discharge of fireworks in the city between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 12:00 a.m. between the dates of June 27th and July 6th.

(b) The governing body of the city may, in its discretion, grant permission at any time for the public display of fireworks by responsible individuals or organizations when such display or displays shall be of such a character and so located, discharged and fired as shall not be a fire hazard or endanger persons or surrounding property.

(c) It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to give any public display of fireworks without having first obtained a permit thereof.

SECTION 2. Section 7-304 of Article 3, Fire, of Chapter VII, Fireworks, of the Code of the City of Burlingame, Kansas, is hereby amended to read as follows:

SAME: EXCEPTION; SALE OF FIREWORKS. Any person who has first obtained a valid permit to sell fireworks within the city may do so between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 12:00 a.m. commencing on June 27th and through July 5th of each year

SECTION 3:

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the governing body, approval by the Mayor, and publication in the official city newspaper.
