

ORDINANCE NO. 1727

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE ELECTRIC LIGHT AND POWER SYSTEM OF THE CITY OF BURLINGAME, SETTING RATES AND CHARGES FOR SERVICE RECEIVED FROM SAID SYSTEM AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NOS. 1552, 1553 AND 1591.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF BURLINGAME:

SECTION 1. That the municipal electric light and power system, effective with the monthly billing for August 1995, shall furnish electrical power consumed or used within and outside the corporate limits at the following monthly charges and rates, thereby eliminating the seasonal rate structure:

Minimum Monthly Service Charge	\$3.00
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Residential	8.74 cents/kwh
Commercial	8.53 cents/kwh
Residential-KCC	7.35 cents/kwh
Commercial-KCC	7.09 cents/kwh

SECTION 2. Economic Development Rate: Electric consumers consuming on an annual basis between 200,000 - 400,000 kwh will be 8.25 cents per kwh and between 400,000 - 600,000 kwh will be 7.32 cents per kwh. Each shall have the minimum monthly service charge of \$3.00.

SECTION 3. A demand charge of 17 cents per kilowatt transformer capacity shall be charged on all 3-phase meter outlets outside the City limits.

SECTION 4. Customers using the above electric rate schedule shall be subject to the same rules, regulations and ordinances that govern all other utility customers.

SECTION 5. That Ordinance Nos. 1552, 1553 and 1591 are hereby repealed.

SECTION 6. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication in the official City newspaper.
