

ORDINANCE NO. 1340

AN ORDINANCE PERTAINING TO THE SOLID WASTE SYSTEM OF THE CITY OF BURLINGAME; SETTING FORTH A PROCEDURE FOR VARIANCE FROM MANDATORY PARTICIPATION IN THE CITY'S REFUSE SERVICE; PROHIBITING USE OF REFUSE SERVICE WITHOUT PAYMENT THEREFOR AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF BURLINGAME, KANSAS:

SECTION I. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to deposit any refuse materials in any dumpster or packer truck or other vehicle belonging to, or under the control of, the City of Burlingame without first paying the required charges or fees for refuse service. Provided, this section shall not apply to the placing of refuse in any dumpster located within the City parks when the refuse is the direct result of an authorized use of the parks.

SECTION II. Any person, firm or corporation desiring to obtain a variance from the requirement for mandatory participation in the City's refuse service, or other service authorized by said City, shall make application to, and receive approval or disapproval from, the Chairman of the City Council Committee on Parks, Dump-yards, Swimming Pool, Health and Planning. Appeal of the Chairman's decision may be made to the Governing Body within fourteen (14) days after the decision is made.

SECTION III. Any person, firm or corporation violating Section I of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, shall be fined not less than \$25.00 or more than \$100.00; Provided, that each day's violation shall be a separate offense.

SECTION IV. This Ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in the official City newspaper.
