

ORDINANCE NO. 1707

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING AN OCCUPATION TAX ON RETAILERS OF ALCOHOLIC LIQUORS BY THE PACKAGE IN THE CITY OF BURLINGAME, KANSAS AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 627.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF BURLINGAME:

SECTION 1. There is hereby levied an annual occupation tax on each retailer of alcoholic liquor for consumption off the premises (sales in the original packages only) in the sum of One Hundred Dollars in the City of Burlingame, Kansas, who has a retailer's license issued by the State Director of Alcoholic Beverage Control, which tax shall be paid before business is begun under an original state license and within and in one day after renewal of a state license.

SECTION 2. A holder of a license for retail sale of alcoholic liquors by the package in the City of Burlingame, Kansas, issued by the State Director of Alcoholic Beverage Control, shall present such license when applying to pay the occupation tax levied in Section 1 and the tax shall be received and receipt issued for the period covered by the state license by the City Clerk.

SECTION 3. Every Licensee shall cause the city alcoholic liquor retailer's occupation tax receipt to be placed in plain view next to or below the state license in a conspicuous place on the licensed premises.

SECTION 4. Any person, copartnership or association having a state license to retail alcoholic liquor by the package who shall fail to pay the occupation tax herein levied and within the time prescribed or who shall violate any other provision of this ordinance shall upon conviction be fined not more than One Hundred Dollars for each day's violation; provided, nothing herein shall be construed to prohibit the city from collecting the occupation tax by any procedure authorized by law.

SECTION 5. That Ordinance No. 627 is hereby repealed.

SECTION 6. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication in the official City newspaper.
