Ordinance 1714 is hereby amended as follows:

Section 1. The following tract of land located within the City limits of the City of Burlingame, Kansas, to-wit: Lots 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, and 28 of the South Park Addition to the City of Burlingame, Kansas, be rezoned to R-2 Multiple Dwelling for the purpose of allowing the construction of multi-family dwelling units.

Section 2. Ordinance 1714 of the City of Burlingame, Kansas, is hereby amended to read that: Lots 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, and 28 of the South Park Addition to the City of Burlingame, Kansas, is hereby rezoned to R-2 Multiple Dwelling, and that a proper change to the zoning classification shall be made on the map disclosing the zoning in the City of Burlingame, Kansas.
