

ORDINANCE NO. 1722

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 151 ESTABLISHING WIDTH OF ROADWAYS.

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF BURLINGAME,
KANSAS:**

Section 1 of Ordinance 151 is hereby amended as follows:

SECTION 1: The width of street parks and roadways on the streets and avenues in the City of Burlingame are hereby established and declared to be established as follows to-wit: The sidewalks and street parks shall occupy Thirty Feet on each side of streets and avenues One Hundred Feet or More in width and the roadways shall occupy the remainder of the street or avenue in the center thereof.

On streets less than One Hundred Feet in width, the roadways shall occupy Forty Feet in the center of such streets and avenues and the sidewalks and street parks shall occupy the remaining portions of such streets and avenues.

The term "Roadway" as herein used is defined as that portion inclusive of any ditches, culverts or curbs with the portion of the roadway for vehicular traffic to be of a minimum width to allow motor vehicles to pass each other in a safe manner while traveling upon the road surface.

SECTION 2: All other Sections of Ordinance No. 151 as stated therein shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3: EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the governing body, approval by the Mayor, and publication in the official city newspaper.
