CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. 2

A CHARTER ORDINANCE EXEMPTING THE CITY OF BURLINGAME, KANSAS, FROM K.S.A. 15-204, K.S.A. 15-205 AND K.S.A. 15-206, AND PROVIDING SUBSTITUTE AND ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS ON THE SAME SUBJECT RELATING TO THE APPOINTMENT OF CERTAIN OFFICERS AND THEIR TERMS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF BURLINGAME, KANSAS:


SECTION I. The City of Burlingame, Kansas, by the power invested in it by Article 12, Section 5, in the Constitution of the State of Kansas, hereby elects to make inapplicable to it and exempts itself from K.S.A. 15-204, K.S.A. 15-205 and K.S.A. 15-206 which apply to said city but not uniformly to all cities, and provides substitute and additional provisions on the same subject as herein provided.

SECTION II. The Mayor shall appoint, by and with the consent of the Council, a City Marshal, City Clerk, City Treasurer, Superintendent of Electricity, Superintendent of Water, Gas and Streets and other such officers as may be deemed necessary. Officers so appointed and confirmed shall hold their offices until resignation, retirement or discharge for cause by the Mayor with the approval of a two-thirds (2/3) majority of the members-elect of the Council. The Council shall by ordinance specify the duties and compensation of all such officers and may by ordinance passed by a two-thirds (2/3) majority of the members-elect of the Council abolish any office so created whenever they may deem it expedient.


SECTION III. This Ordinance shall be published once each week for two (2) consecutive weeks in the official city newspaper.

SECTION IV. This is a Charter Ordinance and shall take effect sixty-one (61) days after final publication, unless a sufficient petition for a referendum is filed in the Office of the City Clerk and a referendum held on the Ordinance as provided in Article 12, Section 5, Subdivision (c)(3) of the Constitution of the State of Kansas, in which case the Ordinance shall become effective if approved by a majority of the electors voting thereon.

PASSED by the Governing Body, not less than two-thirds of the members-elect voting in favor thereof, and approved by the Mayor this 23rd day of January, 1967.
