

ORDINANCE NO. 1903

AN ORDINANCE ATTESTING TO THE INCREASE IN TAXES LEVIED FOR BUDGET YEAR 2001 NECESSARY TO FINANCE PUBLIC SERVICES FOR THE CITY OF BURLINGAME.

SECTION 1. In accordance with state law, the City of Burlingame has conducted a public hearing and has published the proposed budget necessary to fund City services from January 1, 2001 until December 31, 2001.

SECTION 2. After careful public deliberations, it is hereby attested that in order to maintain the public services, which are essential for the citizens of this City, it will be necessary to utilize property tax revenues in an amount which exceeds the revenues expended in the budget year 2000.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect after its passage by the Council, approval of the Mayor and publications once in the official City newspaper.
