

ORDINANCE NO. 2097

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SUMMER ENERGY COST ADJUSTMENT SURCHARGE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF BURLINGAME, KANSAS:

Section 1. The City may adjust the energy charges per kilowatt-hour (kWh) for the summer months of June, July, August, and September that it deems necessary to pass through increase in the cost of fuel and purchased energy.

Section 2. That the municipal electric light and power system, beginning with the June 2007 usage shall have a summer energy cost adjustment surcharge.

Section 3. The summer energy cost adjustment shall end with the September 2007 usage.


Section 4. The resulting summer energy cost adjustment will be calculated in direct proportion compared to a summer base cost of 5.6106 cents per kWh. The adjustment shall be made using the following formula:

$$\frac{\text{Dollar cost of: fuel, oil, natural gas plus purchased power}}{\text{Revenue producing kWh delivered to customers}}$$

Section 5. The energy cost adjustment surcharge under this section is applicable to all users to whom bills are rendered and from whom money normally is collected for electrical energy delivered.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force after its passage by the governing body, approval by the mayor, and publication in the official city newspaper.

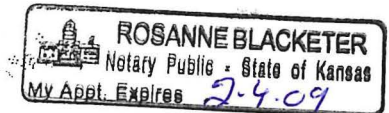
