

ORDINANCE NO. 1749

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN LAND TO THE CITY OF BURLINGAME, KANSAS,
IN CONFORMITY WITH K.S.A. 12-520, AS AMENDED.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF BURLINGAME:

SECTION 1. The following described lands, to-wit:

1. A tract of land in Section 14-T15S-R14E of the 6th P.M., said tract consisting of the right-of-way of U.S. Highway 56 lying in the SW 1/4 of said section, more specifically described as follows:

All of the Highway US 56 right-of-way lying in the southwest quarter of Section 14-T15S-R14E, which is north of the north right-of-way line of the abandoned A.T. & Santa Fe Railroad, and south of the south line of Banks Avenue.

2. A tract of land in Section 14-15-14, said tract consisting of the right-of-way of Banks Avenue lying in the SW 1/4 of said section, more specifically described as follows:

All of the Banks Avenue right-of-way lying in the southwest quarter of Section 14-T15S-R14E, which is east of the right-of-way line of Highway 56 and west of the right-of-way line of the abandoned A.T. & Santa Fe Railroad.

meeting one or more of the classifications for annexation prescribed by K.S.A. 12-520, as amended, is hereby annexed and made a part of the City of Burlingame, Kansas.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication in the Osage County Chronicle, the official City newspaper.
