

ORDINANCE NO. 1460

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE RUNNING AT LARGE OF CATTLE, HORSES, ASSES, MULES, SHEEP, PIGS, OR OTHER ANIMALS OR FOWLS, WITHIN THE CORPORATE CITY LIMITS OF BURLINGAME, KANSAS, AND PROVIDING FOR VIOLATIONS OF THE ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF BURLINGAME, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. That any person, partnership, or corporation, owning or having control or possession of any cattle, horses, asses, mules, sheep, pigs, or other animals, or fowls, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor if said animals or fowls are running at large within the corporate limits of Burlingame, Kansas, and upon being adjudged guilty shall be subject to a fine not less than Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00) and not to exceed One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for each such offense and for each day that animal(s) or fowl are running at large shall constitute a separate offense.


SECTION 2. That said animals or fowls shall be deemed "running at large" if the animals or fowls are off of the premises of the owner or off of the premises where they are being kept, or where said animals or fowls are outside of any enclosure which had been previously been utilized for their confinement. That proof that animals or fowls are upon the premises of another or upon public streets, alleys, or right of ways, or other public place, shall constitute prima facie evidence that said animals or fowls are running at large.

SECTION 3. That any other ordinance, or parts thereof, which conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall be published in the Osage County Chronicle, the Official paper of said City, as provided for by law.
