

ORDINANCE NO. 1563

AN ORDINANCE PRESCRIBING COMPREHENSIVE TRAFFIC CODE AND ESTABLISHING COURT COSTS AND FEES IN THE MUNICIPAL COURT OF BURLINGAME, KANSAS, FOR THE CITY OF BURLINGAME, KANSAS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF BURLINGAME, KANSAS:

Repeals*
SECTION 1. The 1990 edition of Standard Traffic Ordinance for Kansas Cities, Published by the League of Kansas Municipalities, is adopted by the City of Burlingame, Kansas.

SECTION 2. In addition the City of Burlingame, Kansas adopts a Schedule of Fines, to be imposed, upon voluntary entry of appearance and upon a plea of guilty or no contest. (K.S.A. 12-4305)

SECTION 3. Pursuant to Charter Ordinance No. 9 of the City of Burlingame, the City of Burlingame hereby adopts the following costs and fees to be assessed in the Municipal Court in the following manner:

When a Defendant in a Municipal case enters into a diversion agreement with the City or appears in Municipal Court and is found guilty or enters a plea of guilty or nolo contendere, the Municipal Judge shall assess Court costs to be paid by the Defendant as follows:

- (A) All traffic violations or violations of the Standard Traffic Code as may be adopted by the City - \$20.00;
- (B) Parking violations - \$10.00;
- (C) All other violations of any ordinance of the City of Burlingame, Kansas - \$20.00;

(D) Diversion Fee in any alcohol or cereal malt beverage related offense - \$50.00;

(E) Diversion fee in any other offense - \$30.00.

All Court costs and fees shall be collected by the Municipal Court or Clerk and paid into the general fund of the City. Any Court costs otherwise assessed may be waived if the amount of any fine as stated on the complaint, citation or uniform notice to appear and complaint form is paid in full by mailing or delivering the same to the Municipal Court Clerk without an appearance by the accused in Municipal Court.

SECTION 4. Waiver; Deferral. The Municipal Judge is empowered to waive Court costs or to permit the payment of the same in installments upon appropriate findings by the Court.


SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication in the Osage County Chronicle, the official City paper of said City.
