

**AN ORDINANCE REGULATING PARKING WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF BURLINGAME, KANSAS.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF BURLINGAME, KANSAS:**

**SECTION 1:** For purposes of this ordinance, the term "vehicle" shall have the meaning and be defined to include every device in, upon or by which any person or property is or may be transported or driven upon a highway or road.

**SECTION 2:** No person shall stop, stand or park any vehicle or machinery of any kind or nature with its own motive power that exceeds 25 feet in length, or any trailer or semi-trailer which together with a connected truck-trailer form of motive power of any kind that in total length exceeds 25 feet, upon the public streets of Santa Fe Avenue from Kansas Avenue to Dacotah Street or upon Topeka Avenue from Lincoln Street to Fremont Street, Burlingame, Kansas, or any alley between the designated streets for any period longer than two consecutive hours.

**SECTION 3:** No person shall disconnect from it's method of motive power any trailer, camper or machinery and leave standing, stopped or parked any such trailer, camper or machinery, upon the public streets of Santa Fe Avenue from Kansas Avenue to Dacotah Street or upon Topeka Avenue from Lincoln Street to Fremont Street, Burlingame, Kansas, or any alley between the designated streets.

**SECTION 4:** No person shall stop, stand or park any vehicle, machinery or trailer upon any public street, alley, or roadway in any manner creating a hazard or obstruction for other traffic upon such street, alley or roadway.

**SECTION 5:** Any law enforcement officer finding any vehicle or property in violation of this ordinance may have the same towed to the nearest storage area for storage with any expenses assessed to the owner of the vehicle or property.

**SECTION 6:** Any person convicted for violating the terms of this ordinance shall be fined in an amount not to exceed \$50.00 for each violation and shall be responsible for any expenses of removal or storage of any property found in violation of this ordinance that had to be towed and or stored. Each day a violation continues shall be considered as a separate violation for purposes of this ordinance.

**SECTION 7:** The provisions of this ordinance are in addition to all other valid ordinances and provisions thereof of the City of Burlingame.

**SECTION 8:** EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the governing body, approval by the Mayor, and publication in the official city newspaper.
